Tax Refund/Receipt - REMINDER

Parishioners who contribute €250 or over a year will have received a new CHY3 form in the post. This certificate replaces the CHY3 which was signed by you in 2013 and was valid for 5 years. This new CHY3 form, once signed, will again be valid for a further 5 years and, of course, it has no implications for you with Revenue. Those parishioners who are eligible for the scheme and have not signed a form in the past, will also have received a CHY3 form.
